The production takes place at Ben Lomond's historic Park Hall, 9400 Mill Street. Subscriber ticket changes and guest ticket purchases open April 10th, and tickets go on sale to the general public April 24th, 2026. Please join us for an **Opening Night Reception** immediately following the performance on May 15th. Community Night is on May 16th, where all tickets are two for \$30, and a post-show talkback on Sunday, May 31st. Please note that **Friday and Saturday performances begin at 7:00 p.m.** for this production. Sunday matinees are at 2:00 p.m.

Who's Afraid of Virginia Woolf? is widely considered to be one of the greatest American plays. The original Broadway production won five 1963 Tony Awards, including Best Play, Best Actor, and Best Actress, and the film based on the play was nominated for 13 Academy Awards and won five. The play is a dark comedy packed with sparkling wit and language that dissects and illuminates the complex marriage of George and Martha over the course of one long, searing, drunken night of dangerous fun and games into which they pull their guests, a young couple with secrets of their own. By the end at dawn, the lines between reality and illusion have been stretched beyond recognition, and lives are changed forever.

This play remains as shocking and truthful today as when Albee wrote it. A masterclass in psychological warfare, the production offers the perfect blend of explosive comedy and harrowing drama. Packed with intellectual depth and unrelenting tension, this play proves that the search for reality amidst a web of illusions is as devastating—and as necessary—as ever.
